

HEERF III- American Recovery Act (ARA) Student Grants Report

Certification and Agreement for HEERF III- American Recovery Act (ARA) Funds.

Total Funds Received

Cameo Beauty Academy has received \$44,362.00 in total funds pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students.

Eligible Students

The estimated total number of students at Cameo Beauty Academy eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 2003(a) (1) of the ARA Grant is 83.

Number of Grants Awarded

The total amount of the Emergency Financial Aid Grant awarded to students under Section(a) (1) of the ARA Act as of January 10, 2022 is 56.

Amount of Grants Awarded

The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants awarded to students under Section(a) (1) of the ARA Act as of January 10, 2022 is \$29,931.44. The amount of funds that have been disbursed to the students is \$29,931.44.

Application and Awarding Process

All currently enrolled students are eligible as of the date grant application is released and must be an active student on day of disbursement.

Award Methodology

To be able to receive the American Recovery Act (ARA)-HEERF III Funds, students must have met all eligibility criteria listed below.

1. Students must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid for 21-22 Financial Aid Year.
2. U.S. citizenship or eligible noncitizen
3. Registered for Selective Service (males only).
4. A High School diploma, GED or completion of a high school in a home setting.
5. Must be currently enrolled in a Title IV program.
6. Students must complete and submit the HEERF III application.

Disbursement

Grants will be delivered to students via paper check.
